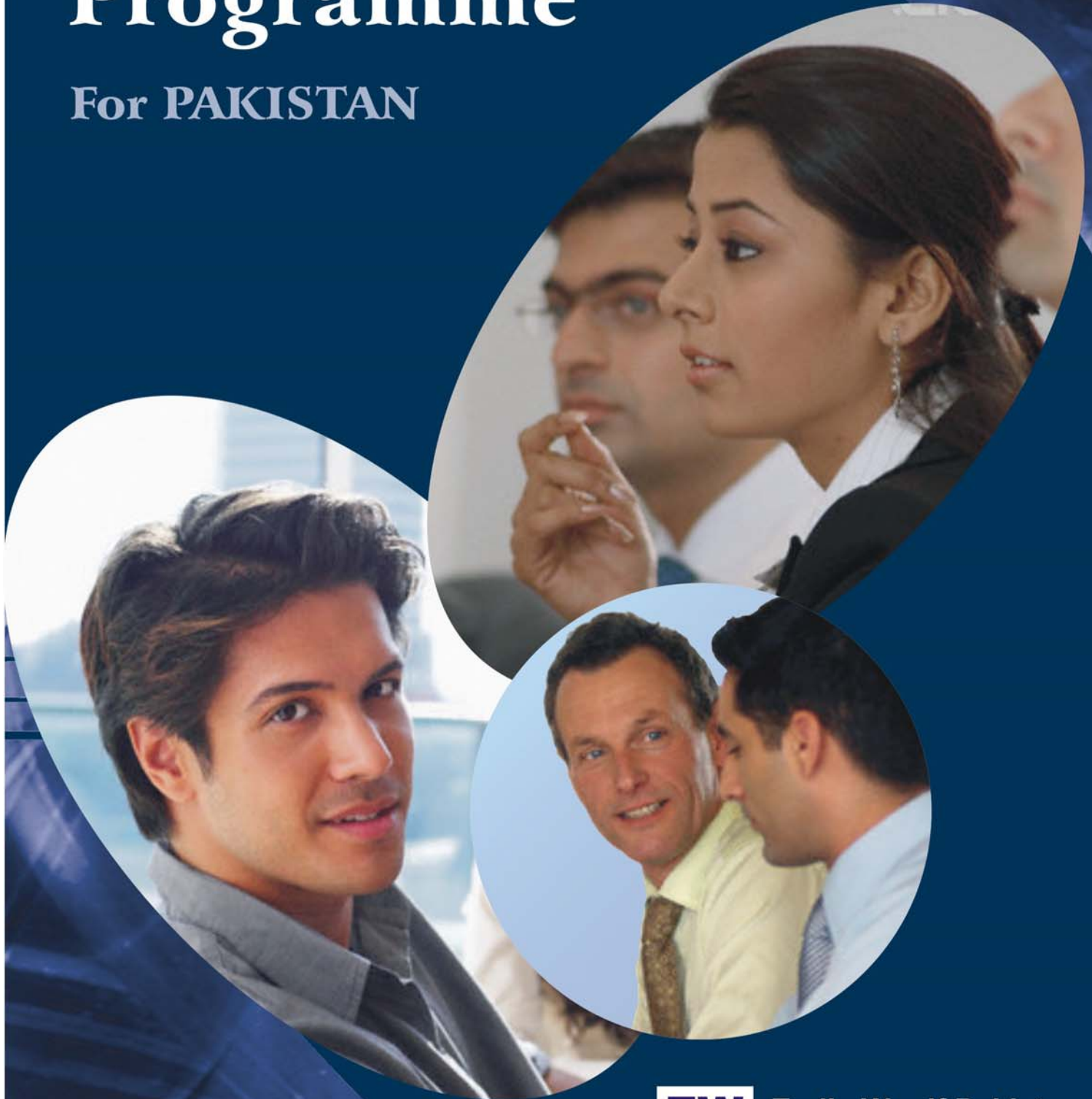

Course Structure

The ICAEW's accelerated programme for Pakistan is designed to provide ICAP members and members of other recognised accountancy bodies access to the internationally renowned ACA Qualification to enhance their personal skills and career development opportunities.

Classes Schedule

UK Tax & Law :	3 Days : orientation (optional)
Technical Integration 1&2	20 Days: Intensive tuition including revision Practice and mock exam.
ACS :	5 Days : Preparation for case study
	5 Days : Further preparation and case study practice.

Fees

The fees package includes cost of study material, classes, revision and mock exam. In the event of a cancellation administrative fee of GBP 100 will be charged. If a cancellation occurs less than two weeks before the start of the course the full fee will be payable.

Exams Schedule

ICAEW exams for Advanced stage are held in July and November each year. Individual students or firms are required to send credit for prior learning and exam entry applications in time directly to the ICAEW.



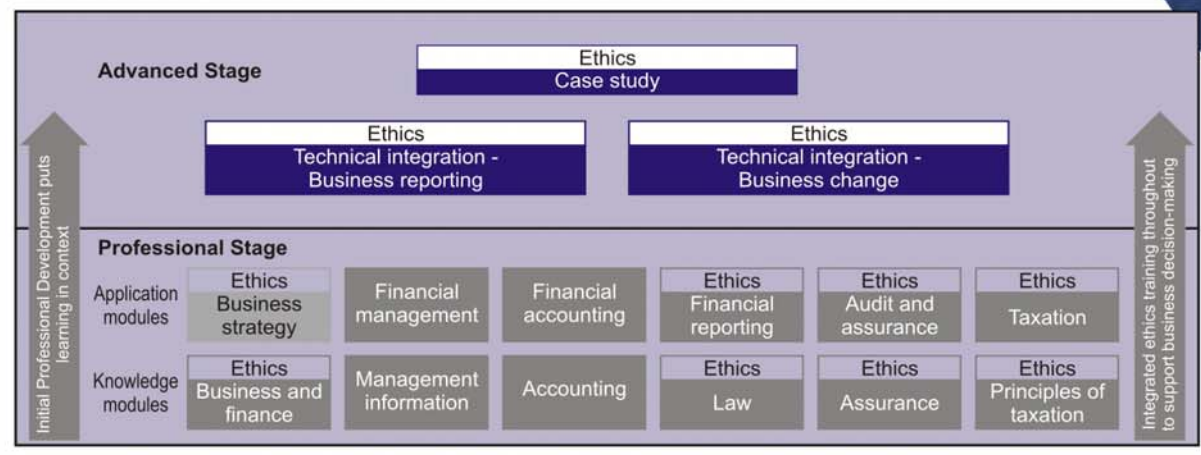

ACA Qualification

The Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales (ICAEW's) ACA qualification is widely recognised throughout the world and offers holders of the qualification many opportunities across a wide range of career enhancing opportunities wherever they are, and in whatever discipline they choose - practice, commerce, public sector and others.



ACA For ICAP Members

The ICAP members are eligible to gain ACA (Eng. & Wales) qualification by sitting and passing three Advanced Level papers*

* Some candidates may be required to sit for the Business Strategy paper of Professional stage.

ACA For ACCA

The ACCA students and members are eligible to gain ACA (Eng. & Wales) qualification by sitting and passing three Advanced Level papers* and gaining two to three years work experience with an Approved Training Employer (ATE).

* Some candidates may be required to sit for the audit and assurance and advanced taxation papers of Professional stage.
